A variety of aesthetic outdoor design will be found on the garden tour. A corresponding exhibit of “Art in Bloom” will be held at the Northfield Arts Guild Gallery, located at 304 Division Street in downtown Northfield on June 24 at 7 to 9 p.m. Floral arrangements created by Northfield Garden Club members will reflect the fine art on display through color, form and/or theme. This exhibit is open to the general public and continues throughout the weekend.

For those seeking more outdoor beauty, you can stroll through Carleton’s Cowling Arboretum or visit Nerstrand Big Woods, just eight miles south of Northfield, where you’ll find wildflowers in bloom and discover a hidden falls.
